This factsheet contains information on **Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC)** in circulation and issued (by one and three years in length) in Great Britain.

DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.

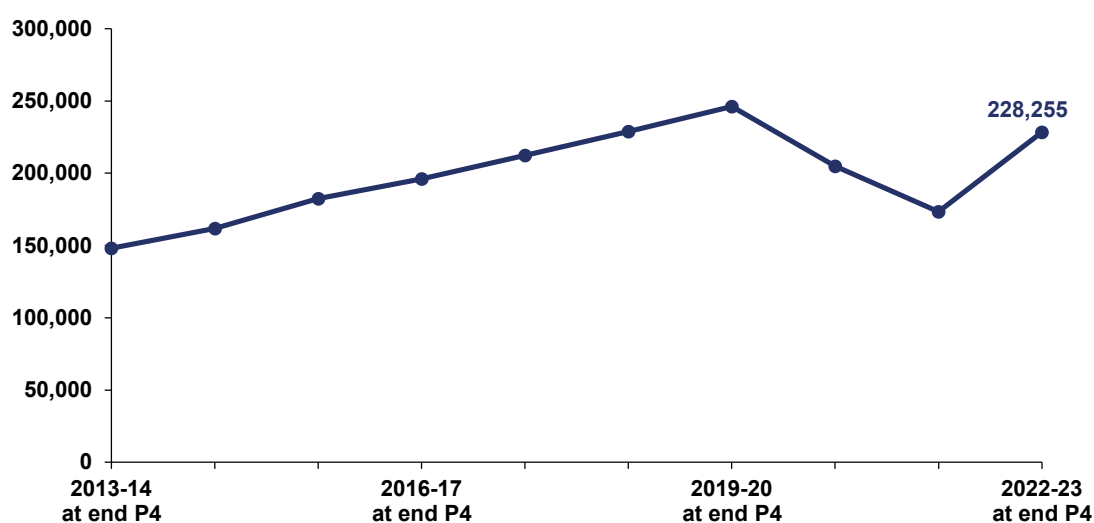

The number of Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC) in circulation increased in rail periods 1 to 4 compared with the same rail periods in the previous year. This reflects the [increase in passenger journeys](#) as pandemic restrictions have eased. The number of DPRC issued has also increased and is now almost back to pre-pandemic levels.

There were **228,255 DPRC in circulation** at the end of rail period 4 (23 July 2022). This is 31.7% higher than the previous year, but 7.2% lower than at the same point three years ago, before the pandemic.

DPRC in circulation at the end of rail period 4 since 2013, Great Britain, (Table 4310)



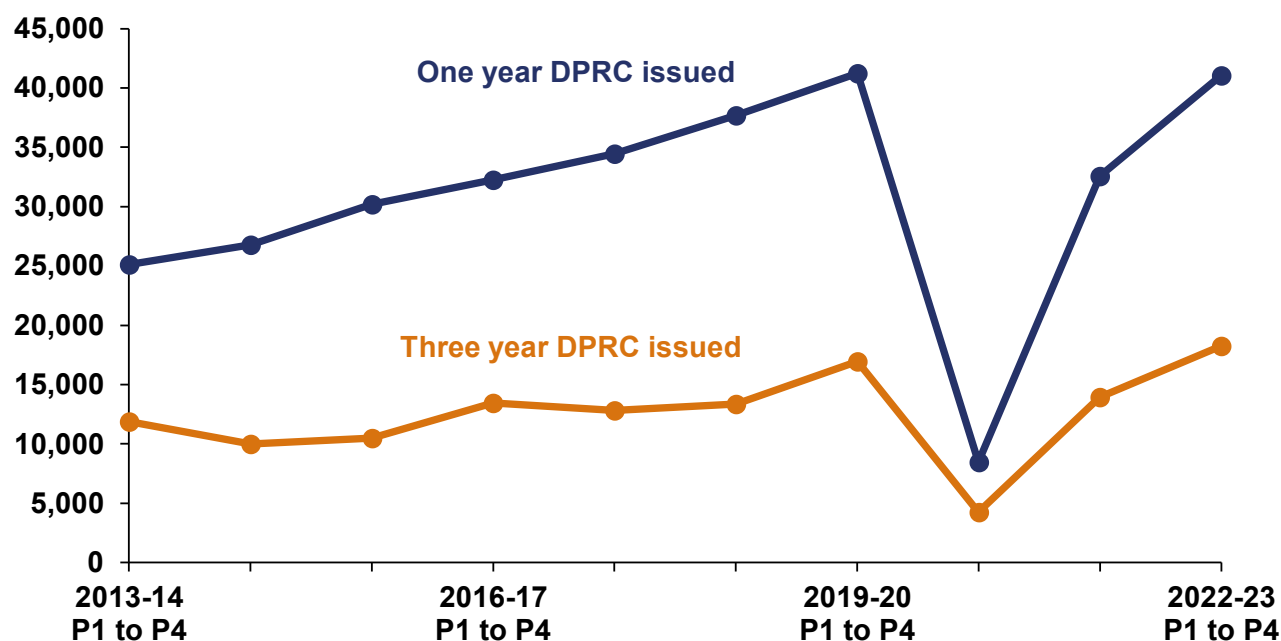
The data table, a quality and methodology report and interactive dashboard associated with this factsheet are published on the [Disabled Persons Railcards page](#) of the data portal. Key definitions are at the end of this factsheet.

Overall, **41,055 one year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 1 to 4 of the latest year. This is 26.1% higher than the same rail periods in the previous year. However, it is 0.5% lower than the same rail periods three years ago.

There were **18,256 three year DPRC** issued during rail periods 1 to 4 of the latest year. This is 30.8% higher than the same rail periods in the previous year and 7.8% higher than the same rail periods three years ago.

Definitions

- **DPRC in circulation:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one year and three year railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.
