This factsheet presents data for the full financial year and the latest three railway periods.

Background:

This factsheet contains information on **Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC)** in **circulation** and **issued** (by one and three years in length) in Great Britain.

DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.

We collect this data as part of our <u>Accessible Travel Policy</u> (ATP) compliance monitoring.



April 2022 to March 2023 annual

There were **242,770 Disabled Persons Railcards** (**DPRC**) in **circulation** at the end of March 2023. This is 11% higher than the number in circulation at same point in the previous year (218,448).


The data table, a quality and methodology report and interactive dashboard associated with this factsheet are published on the <u>Disabled Persons Railcards page</u> of the data portal. Key definitions are at the end of this factsheet.



Overall, **123,987 one-year DPRC** were issued in the latest year (1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023), an increase of 17% on the number issued in the previous year.

There were **53,019 three-year DPRC** issued in the latest year (1 April 2022 to 31 March 2023), an increase of 11% on the number issued in the previous year.

Rail periods 11 to 13 (8 January to 31 March 2023)

Overall, **26,502 one-year DPRC** were issued during rail periods 11 to 13 of the latest year. This is 27% higher than the same rail periods in the previous year.

There were **11,057 three-year DPRC** issued during rail periods 11 to 13 of the latest year. This is 1% higher than the same rail periods in the previous year.

Definitions

- DPRC enable disabled passengers to get a discount of a third off adult rail fares for travel on the National Rail network in Great Britain.
- **DPRC in circulation:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards in circulation which are valid to use for a discount on rail fares. This includes both one-year and three-year railcards.
- **DPRC issued:** The number of Disabled Persons Railcards that have been issued during the year. These can be either for one year or three years in length.

Table 4310 - Disabled Persons Railcards (DPRC) in circulation and issued can be accessed on the <u>Disabled Persons Railcards page</u> of the data portal free of charge in OpenDocument Spreadsheet (.ods) format.
